CELEBRATING THE FRUIT of the **PAST 12 MONTHS**

Through God's blessing, we witness the donation of time, talent, and financial support that bring hope to people suffering material poverty in the Dominican Republic (DR) and Guatemala. We are witnessing pastors and churches becoming passionately healthy disciple-makers who love their neighbors.

We witness lives being transformed and families accepting Christ as their Lord and Savior. We are encouraged as those families join the local church and help transform their communities. God is multiplying spiritual seeds planted to bear great fruit! May we not grow weary as His faithful sowers (Galatians 6:9-10).

Join us in celebrating the fruit of the past 12 months!

- ✓ 15,427 ADULTS CAME TO CHRIST IN JUST 12 MONTHS!
- ✓ 139 churches were trained in Natural Church Development in the DR, and 19 were trained in Guatemala, for a total of 2,671 churches in the last 13 years.
- ✓ 2,784 new community ministries were launched, including preschools for single moms, family counseling, prison ministry, housing improvement for the impoverished, and elder care.
- ✓ LoveServes has 9 coaches, each one touching 50 to 60 pastors/churches.
- ✓ 81 new pastors and 68 of their key leaders attended the 3-day Vision Conference, which
 ignites a paradigm shift
- ✓ Now in Florida: The inaugural group of U.S. pastors has completed 8 months of training; the second group will launch by early 2020.
- ✓ A total of 103 people (just like YOU) went on LoveServes mission trips, serving alongside 7 different Dominican churches

- For all nations to have healthy churches, equipping God's people to make disciples, who then make disciples. (Matthew 28:19a "make disciples of all nations")
- For the faithful execution of our mission: to walk alongside pastors, mentoring and coaching them to develop a healthy Church that equips its members to love God and love their neighbor
- For pastors throughout the world, that they will "not become weary in doing good"; for unity and love among the body of Christ
- For our staff: strength, wisdom, balance, and focus
- In the U.S.: For God to bring the next 10 pastors to the Four12 Pastor Peer Group. These U.S. pastors will walk in the path that has energized 2,652 Dominican pastors.
- For 3 replacement ministry vehicles for our DR coaches (\$60,000)
- For like-minded people, churches, and organizations to join this important work and for expansion into other nations

Ephesians 4:12 says that God purposefully and uniquely gifted each of us "for the training of the saints in the work of ministry, to build up the body of Christ." This year, 103 men, women, and young people served as the hands and feet of Jesus alongside local Dominican church members. They stepped into an 8-day experience to work, serve, play, and pray together, with transformational outcomes. God is continuing to grow His Church: A Story of Transformation

Albania Zapata and the community of Mata Gorda

"I was a violent woman. I fought with women, with men. I didn't care if it was a police officer who provoked me. I was always ready to fight!" remembers Albania Zapata, a young woman with a sordid past on the streets of her native Baní.

At an early age, Albania was introduced to the world of witchcraft and, later, began to use drugs. In a short time, she

was selling marijuana, cocaine, and crack. Her sister, a member of the Assemblies of God Church in Mata Gorda, a rural community 37 miles west of Santo Domingo, had always shared the Gospel with Albania. Albania listened to her sister, but her ties to drugs and obscene altars were powerful. Pastor Julio Díaz was part of the first LoveServes training networks. The vision he received through his association with coach Rafael Tejeda sensitized him to work with people like Albania, so when she finally agreed to go to Mata Gorda with her sister, the congregation was ready to receive her. Albania decided to accept Jesus as her Lord!

"The church supported me", Albania says. "They didn't isolate me but instead made me part of the work immediately. My pastor is a man of God who has taught me and guided me in the ministry in which I serve today. I've received a lot of love from my pastor and the church leaders. When that happens, it's certain that you'll grow as a Christian.

"People like me—those who are in the grip of drugs—are rejected and taken out of society, so I work with them now, because that's where God found me. The pastor has nicknamed me 'the Ambulance' because I love carrying sick people from one hospital to another. I don't get tired of serving. God has given me the missionary ministry, and I feel His presence when I'm helping someone who's sick, hungry, or enslaved by idolatry and vice."

Not only Albania was transformed. Pastor Julio Díaz testifies that Mata Gorda was once a violent community. Brawls often began in three bars on the same street, leaving many people wounded. Today it's different. The bars are gone, and the church continues to grow. In fact, Albania is a leader in a new church that was planted in a crowded neighborhood in Baní.

THE IMPACT OF A CHURCH THAT REACHES OUT: Once an addict, drug dealer, and sorceress whom even men feared, Albania is now a servant of Christ who glorifies His name by serving those in need, especially those who live enslaved to sin. She is truly a transformed woman!
